

## OVERVIEW:

- Freezing drizzle or light freezing rain will combine with cold initial temperatures to produce slippery, icy untreated roads.
- Adverse impact to the Wednesday AM commute.
- A light glaze of icing expected.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Freezing rain or freezing drizzle begins pre-dawn Wednesday, continuing through the morning hours.</li> <li>Temperatures warm above freezing by noon.</li> </ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Slippery, icy roads due to a light glaze of icing.</li> </ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Winter Weather Advisory for most areas north and west of Interstate 95, from 5-AM to Noon Wednesday.</li> </ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Chance that temperatures may be slower to warm above freezing, especially in typically colder valleys in northern MA. Could result in a longer duration of light icing.</li> </ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Temps warm above freezing (40s/low 50s) by afternoon with rains.</li> <li>Watching another possible storm late Thu/Fri.</li> </ul>
<b>NEXT BRIEFING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>This will be the last briefing unless the forecast changes</li> </ul>
