


Jan 6th/7th Snowfall

OVERVIEW:

- Potential exists for an impactful winter storm Thursday night into Friday
- Current worst case scenario is 6-12 inches of snow

TIMING	▪ Thursday night into Friday	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	▪ Potential for heavy snowfall and reduced visibility resulting in hazardous travel conditions	
NWS ALERTS	▪ None at this time.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ Considerable uncertainty with respect to the storm track which will dictate where and how much snow will fall	
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	▪ The map below is a reasonable worst case scenario (1 in 10 chance of being exceeded) and is not the official forecast.
