




Jan 6th-7th Snowfall Potential

OVERVIEW:

- High confidence in accumulating snow, but amounts and westward extent remain uncertain very late Thursday night into Friday
- Friday morning rush hour will likely be impacted

TIMING	▪ Very late Thursday night into Friday		
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ The combination of snow and reduced visibility would result in hazardous travel that would impact the Friday AM commute▪ Temperatures will be cold enough that snow will stick immediately on untreated paved surfaces		
NWS ALERTS	▪ None at this time.		
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Considerable uncertainty with respect to the storm track - this will dictate amounts and westward extent of them▪ Precipitation Type issues confined to mainly the Cape/Islands with all snow elsewhere		
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	▪ The map below shows the probabilities of exceeding 2" and 4" of total snow. Also attached (not shown) are the probabilities of exceeding 6" and 8" of snow.
