


### Overview


- Quick-hitting winter storm with 2-3 hours window of 1-2"/hour snowfall rate across Eastern MA and RI that coincides with Friday morning commute between 6-9 AM.
- First winter storm of the season
- No coastal flood issues Friday & Saturday
  - Surge around 1-1.5 ft, but offshore winds (NW) & lower astro tides compared to this past weekend

# **Onset & Ending Time**






## Winter Storm Warning



 Warning area is where we have the highest confidence on impact to the Friday morning commute

## **Snowfall Amounts**



- Main event will be between 5-10 AM Friday
- 1-2 inches per hour snowfall rates coinciding with AM commute in Eastern MA & RI
- Snow will stick immediately on untreated paved surfaces
- Snow for Cape & the Islands, except for Nantucket where rain could mix in.

### Post Event Temperatures


### Saturday

Sub-freezing temperatures common (except South Coast, Cape and Islands). Little if any melt expected.


#### Sunday


Better odds for snowmelt Sunday. Wintry mix to rain event.

Possible freeze-up Sunday night as temps fall into the 20s Sunday night.

## Summary

- High confidence in accumulating snow very late tonight into Friday
- Hazardous travel due to 1-2 inches/hour snowfall rate coinciding with the Friday AM commute including I-95 corridor
- Dry, but cold & blustery Friday night into Saturday
