NWS ALERTS	 Winter Weather Advisory in effect 7am-7pm Sunday for Worcester, Franklin, Hampshire, Hampden, and Berkshire counties in MA and Tolland, Hartford, Litchfield, Fairfield, and New Haven counties in CT. 	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	 How far east will the freezing rain threat extend? Exact timing for the changeover from freezing rain to all rain? How much if any impact does gusty south winds have on ice accumulation?
