



- ✓ Less risk for widespread slippery travel issues this evening



















Forecast Storm Total Snowfall

Expected Snowfall - Official NWS Forecast Valid: Friday Evening












Forecast Maximum Wind Gusts









Forecast Minimum Wind Chills

Min Apparent Temperature
















Forecast Maximum Wave Heights (Ft)

Maximum Wave Height Valid: 01/14/2022 06:00 PM - 01/15/2022 10:00 AM EST
























Probability 4+" Snow Late Sunday Night/Monday














Probability 6+" Snow Late Sunday Night/Monday











Threat Event Summary

- ✓ Confidence: High on dangerously cold wind chills, high winds, & slippery travel
- ✓ What:



Wind Gusts 50-55 mph SE coastal MA and 60-70 mph Cape Cod and Islands



Dangerously cold wind chills 15 to 30 below zero



Potential icy roads from rain changing to snow with rapidly falling temperatures in far southeast MA.

- ✓ Where: All of Southern New England
- ✓ When: Late Friday into Saturday
