

Accumulating Snow Thurs.

OVERVIEW:

- Initial rain or snow at onset overnight tonight changes to all snow by Thursday morning.
- Minor snow accumulation with possible travel impacts to the Thursday AM commute along and south of the MA Turnpike.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any initial rain changes to all snow between 4-8 AM. Reduced visibility & accumulation on roads between 5 AM to noon. Snow tapers off into the afternoon from NW to SE. 	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Difficult travel, especially during the Thursday AM commute, due to areas of reduced visibility and slippery roads. 	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No winter weather alerts active at this time. Winter Weather Advisories could be needed in some areas if snow amounts increase further. 	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Localized higher amounts to 4 inches possible, especially in the swath of 2-3 inch snow area. There may be a sharp cutoff in snow amounts between Hartford, Worcester to Boston. 	
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hourly snowfall rates mainly less than one inch per hour. 	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wind chills 5 to 15 below zero Thursday night. Monitoring a possible coastal storm this weekend. 	<p>Expected Snowfall - Official NWS Forecast Valid: 01/19/2022 07:00 PM - 01/20/2022 07:00 PM EST</p>
