

Minor accumulating snow Thursday

WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Initial rain or snow at onset overnight tonight changes to all snow by Thursday morning.
- Minor snow accumulation with possible travel impacts to the Thursday AM commute along and south of the MA Turnpike.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Any initial rain changes to all snow between 5-9 AM.▪ Reduced visibility & accumulation on roads between 5 AM to noon.▪ Snow tapers off into the afternoon from NW to SE.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Slow travel during the Thursday AM commute due to reduced visibilities and areas of slippery roads.	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ A Special Weather Statement has been issued for areas south and east of I-84 and I-90 corridor.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Localized higher amounts to 3 inches possible, especially in the swath of I-2 inch snow area.▪ Uncertainty how far N and W precipitation gets.▪ Timing of changeover from rain to snow.	
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Hourly snowfall rates mainly half inch per hour or less.▪ Roads expected to remain mainly wet across the coastal plains. Best chance of roads getting snow covered is across interior higher elevation.	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Wind chills -5 to -15 overnight Thursday.▪ Scattered ocean effect snow showers across Outer Cape Thursday night.▪ Possible coastal storm should remain well to our south this weekend	<p>Expected Snowfall - Official NWS Forecast Valid: Thursday</p>
