



OVERVIEW:

- Rain changes to minor accumulating snow this morning with possible impact to AM travel near/south of the MA Turnpike.
- Much colder air tonight brings low wind chills, lowest in the Berkshires.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ [Snow Hazards] Initial rain changes to all snow thru 9 AM with minor accumulation thru noon. Ending by this afternoon. ▪ [Wind Chill Hazards] Lowest wind chills by daybreak Friday AM.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ [Snow Hazards] Slow travel into AM commute due to reduced visibilities and slippery roads. ▪ [Wind Chill Hazards] Frostbite possible in as little as 30 minutes in the Berkshires.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ [Snow Hazards] Winter Weather Advisory for South Coastal CT until 1 PM; Special Weather Statement for minor snow accumulation for areas along & south of MA Turnpike. ▪ [Wind Chill Hazards] Wind Chill Advisory for the Berkshires & Northern Litchfield County CT from 1 AM until 9 AM Friday.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ [Snow Hazards] Localized higher amounts to 3 inches possible, especially in the 1-2 inch forecast snow swath area. ▪ [Wind Chill Hazards] Wind chills may drop to -15F in Northern Worcester County.
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Hourly snowfall rates mainly half-inch per hour or less.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Scattered ocean effect snow showers across Cape Cod & South Shore tonight thru Saturday. ▪ Cold but dry Friday.
