- Additional accumulations between one-half and 2 inches. Localized amounts to 4 inches possible in coastal Plymouth County.

NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Winter Weather Advisory for Eastern Plymouth & Barnstable Counties in MA until 4 PM today. No changes were made to this Advisory from earlier briefings.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Snow amounts & conditions to vary considerably over short distances, as snow showers will be narrow and oscillate across Plymouth & Barnstable Counties. ▪ Will any minor accumulations make it westward than the immediate coast?
