- Coastal low-pressure system may impact the northeast US late week/early weekend
- Exact track of storm still **highly uncertain**

✓ What We Know

- A potential coastal storm passing near or east of Southern New England later Fri into Sat night
- Astronomical tides rise Fri into the weekend

? Unanswered Questions

- Exact track & strength of the storm
- Precipitation type and accumulation, wind gust speeds, possible coastal flooding

💻 What You Can Do Now

- Monitoring forecast closely
- Consider alternate plans for any planned activities Fri thru Sat night

HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Potential exists for heavy snow, strong winds, and coastal flooding
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Exact track of storm will determine where the greatest impacts will be▪ Exact timing of impacts also remains uncertain
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Confidence in any potential impacts for southern New England will grow considerably over the next 36-48 hours
