

## OVERVIEW:

- Light snow to wintry mix event for interior MA/CT to the east slopes of the Berkshires.
- Coating to 2 inches of new snow plus a light glaze of ice.
- Greatest impact for the Monday PM rush into early overnight.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Initial light snow spreads north early Monday PM, turning to a wintry mix into the Monday PM rush hour period. Ends as flurries or light snow into the pre-dawn hours Tuesday.</li> <li>▪ Greatest impact timing is after sundown: from the Monday PM rush into early overnight.</li> </ul>
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Difficult travel due to slickened roads from light accumulations of snow and ice.</li> </ul>
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Winter Weather Advisory</b> for northern CT, western &amp; central MA (including the eastern slopes of the Berkshires) from Noon Monday to 7 AM Tuesday.</li> </ul>
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Road condition (wet vs icy) is in some question due to marginal temperatures between 30-34F. Worst conditions more likely in the higher terrain.</li> </ul>
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ High confidence in a mainly rain precipitation type throughout with nil impact for eastern MA and RI.</li> </ul>
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Temps Tuesday thru Thursday warm into the 40s, with dry weather.</li> </ul>
