


## OVERVIEW:

- Light snow to wintry mix event for interior MA/CT
- Coating to an inch of snow plus a light glaze of ice. Up to 2 inches possible higher terrain in northern MA
- Greatest impact for the PM commute

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Initial light snow/freezing drizzle spreads north in CT later this morning with light snow/wintry mix interior MA this afternoon</li> <li>▪ Precip changes to rain in CT and south of the Mass Pike late today/this evening and overnight in northern MA</li> </ul>
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Slippery roads from light accumulations of snow and ice</li> </ul>
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Winter Weather Advisory</b> for northern CT and Hampden and southern Worcester counties until 7 PM</li> <li>▪ <b>Winter Weather Advisory</b> for interior MA north of the Mass Pike from 10 AM Monday to 7 AM Tuesday</li> </ul>
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Road condition (wet vs icy) due to marginal temperatures around 32.</li> <li>▪ Worst conditions more likely in the higher terrain.</li> </ul>
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ High confidence in mainly rain with no impact for eastern MA. Brief wintry mix possible in northern and western RI later this morning, then all rain.</li> </ul>
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<div data-bbox="254 1248 496 1634"> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Rain ends Tuesday morning.</li> <li>▪ Temps Tuesday thru Thursday warm into the 40s, with dry weather.</li> </ul> </div> <div data-bbox="536 1238 1423 1798">  </div>
