- Accumulating snowfall across much of southern New England on Sunday into early Monday
- 3 to 6 inches of snow across southeast MA, including the Cape/Islands
- Totals of I to 3 inches for the I-95 corridor & less than an inch north of the MA Pike & W of I-495

NWS ALERTS	 Winter Weather Advisory for Plymouth, Barnstable, Dukes & Nantucket counties until 6 AM Monday.
