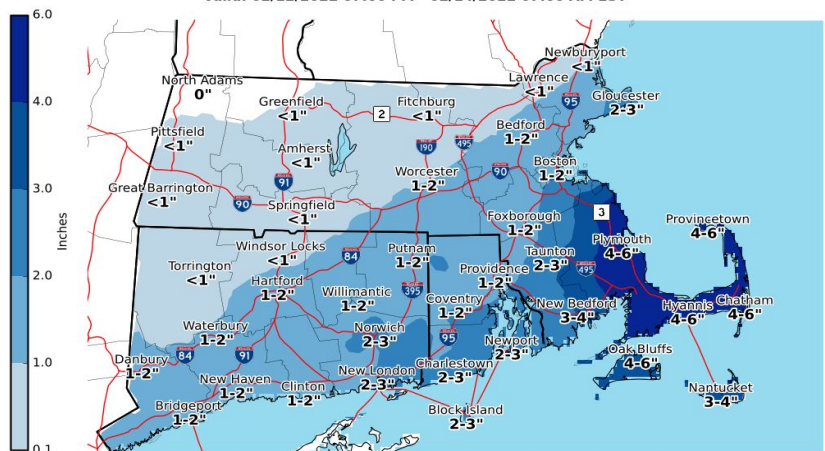
WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Accumulating snowfall across much of southern New England on Sunday into early Monday
- 3 to 6 inches of snow across southeast MA, including the Cape/Islands
- Totals of 1 to 3 inches for the I-95 corridor & less than an inch north of the MA Pike & W of I-495

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow spreads in from southwest to northeast starting early Sunday▪ Heaviest across southeast MA Sunday afternoon & Sunday night▪ Tapers off late Sunday/early Monday	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Slippery road conditions on any untreated surfaces	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Winter Weather Advisory for Plymouth, Barnstable, Dukes & Nantucket counties until 6 AM Monday.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ How much snow accumulates on roads Sunday & location of the heaviest snow bands Sunday night.	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Drier, but cold on Monday with highs in the teens to low 20s.
