

OVERVIEW:

- Arctic cold front will likely lead to brief period of snow squalls or heavy snow showers along with gusty winds and reduced visibility.
- Icy spots along with a potential flash freeze, due to any residual road moisture from mixed rain/snow or melting snow freezing, after the passage of the snow squalls.

TIMING	 Saturday I-2 PM for western CT/MA, 3-5 PM for RI/eastern MA and 5-7 PM for Cape Cod and Islands. 	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	 Icy spots/possible flash freeze from wet pavement with temperatures plummeting following passage of the arctic cold front. 	
NWS ALERTS	 None currently but there could be a short-fused Special Weather Statement. 	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	 How widespread will the snow squalls and flash freeze will be. 	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	 Cold but plenty of sunshine with SW gusts 20-30 mph on Sunday. 	What radar may look like on Sat, 5 PM
