


OVERVIEW:

- Arctic cold front will likely lead to brief period of snow squalls or heavy snow showers along with gusty winds and reduced visibility.
- Icy spots along with a potential flash freeze, due to any residual road moisture from mixed rain/snow or melting snow freezing, after the passage of the snow squalls.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Icy spots/possible flash freeze from wet pavement with temperatures plummeting following passage of the arctic cold front. 	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ None currently but there could be a short-fused Special Weather Statement. 	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ How widespread will the snow squalls and flash freeze will be.
