## Feb 25 Winter Storm



## **OVERVIEW:**

- A winter storm will bring accumulating snow and perhaps a bit of ice to Southern New England on Friday.
- Precipitation likely starts off as a period of moderate to heavy snow during the pre-dawn hours, then perhaps changes to wintry mix across portions of the region.
- Greatest risk of 6+ inches of snow north of the Mass Pike.

TIMING	<ul> <li>Beginning Friday pre-dawn hours</li> <li>Tapering off late Friday night/early Saturday morning</li> </ul>	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul> <li>Friday morning commute will be impacted, and possibly evening commute.</li> <li>Snowfall rates of an inch per hour or greater will be likely for a period of time, possibly coinciding with the Friday morning commute.</li> </ul>	
NWS ALERTS	<ul> <li>None currently but Winter weather headlines will likely be needed with subsequent forecast packages.</li> </ul>	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul> <li>Uncertainty in timing of changeover from snow to wintry mix</li> <li>Location of the changeover line</li> </ul>	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul> <li>Below normal temperatures with highs in the 30s but mostly dry this weekend.</li> </ul>	Probability of $\geq$ 6 inches of snow over 24 hours on Friday
