## Feb 25 Winter Storm



## **OVERVIEW:**

- A winter storm will bring accumulating snow and ice to Southern New England Friday.
- Precipitation likely starts off as a period of moderate to heavy snow during the pre-dawn hours, then likely changes to a wintry mix across portions of the region.
- Greatest risk for 6+ inches of snow north of the Mass Pike.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul> <li>Friday morning commute will be impacted, and possibly evening commute.</li> <li>Snowfall rates of an inch per hour or greater will be likely for a period of time, possibly coinciding with the Friday morning commute.</li> </ul>		
NWS ALERTS	<ul> <li>Winter Storm Watch from midnight Friday to midnight Saturday.</li> </ul>		
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul> <li>Uncertainty in timing of changeover from snow to wintry mix</li> <li>Location of the changeover line</li> <li>Uncertainty in timing and location of second band of snow late in the day</li> </ul>		
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul> <li>Below normal temperatures. Lows mainly 10-20 Friday night. Highs in the 30s Saturday. Dry weather expected this weekend.</li> </ul>	8.0 North Adams Lawrence	Bryport 12: Glouester 8-12: B-12:
