

OVERVIEW:

- A winter storm will bring accumulating snow and ice to Southern New England Friday.
- Precipitation likely starts off as a period of moderate to heavy snow during the pre-dawn hours, then likely changes to a wintry mix across portions of the region.
- Greatest risk for 6+ inches of snow north of the Mass Pike.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Beginning Friday pre-dawn hours ▪ Tapering off late Friday night/early Saturday morning
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Friday morning commute will be impacted, and possibly evening commute. ▪ Snowfall rates of an inch per hour or greater will be likely for a period of time, possibly coinciding with the Friday morning commute.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Winter Storm Watch from midnight Friday to midnight Saturday.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Uncertainty in timing of changeover from snow to wintry mix ▪ Location of the changeover line ▪ Uncertainty in timing and location of second band of snow late in the day
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Below normal temperatures. Lows mainly 10-20 Friday night. Highs in the 30s Saturday. Dry weather expected this weekend.
