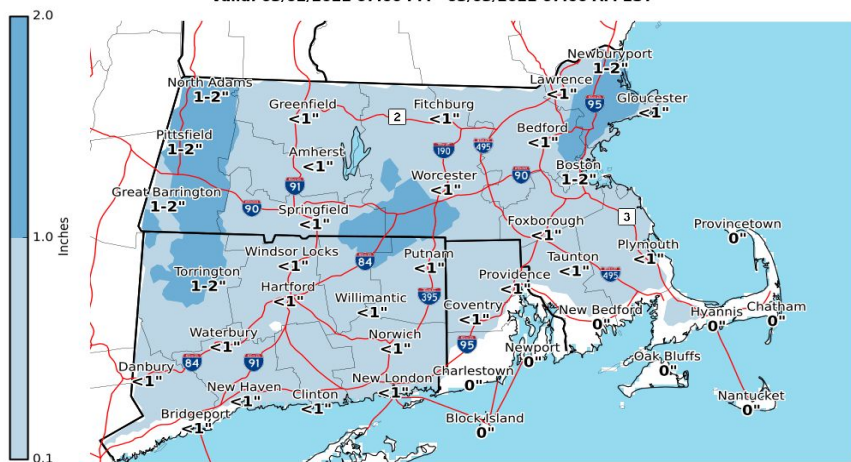


OVERVIEW:

- Initial light rain to change to a brief (1-3 hr) period of steady light to moderate snow early Thursday morning for Hartford-Providence corridor northward
- Sub-freezing temperatures after snow ends could freeze any untreated pavement that is wet, snow or slush-covered.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rain transitions to snow between 2 to 7 AM, steadiest snow between 3-6 AM, ending after 8 AM. Sub-freezing temps through late AM.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Slippery travel Thursday AM/AM commute due to brief period of low-visibility snow and untreated wet, snow or slush-covered roads.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> None at this time.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> How much snow will stick to pavement? Location of moderate-intensity snow
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> None.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Temperatures fall below freezing again Thurs PM. Dry and seasonable Friday.
