## Mid-March Winter Storm



## **OVERVIEW:**

- Widespread moderate to heavy rainfall for much of Saturday.
- Rain likely to transition to areas of snow across western MA & CT.
- Gusty northwest winds late Saturday night through late Sunday morning.

## TIMING

- Rain: Predawn Saturday through mid afternoon
- Snow: Rain transitions to snow from northwest to southeast late Saturday morning through early Saturday afternoon.
- Wind: Strongest winds Saturday night through late Sunday morning as northwest winds gust 30 to 40 mph.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

 Moderate to heavy rainfall could lead to minor poor drainage and urban flooding.

- Icy and slick roadways possible for western areas that have accumulating snow and sub-freezing temperatures.
- Strong gusts could produce minor tree and powerline damage.
- Winter Storm Watch for northern Berkshire County from I AM March 12th to I AM March 13th.
- Confidence of the positioning of the low pressure system as any deviation could impact snow totals across western MA & CT.
