

OVERVIEW:

- Period of freezing rain overnight Wednesday into early Thursday morning across the higher terrain of the Berkshires and northern Worcester Hills.
- Transitioning to rain by early Thursday morning, although freezing rain may linger across the highest elevations through noon.
- Soaking rain for much of Thursday with no flooding concerns.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Freezing rain arrives around midnight for higher terrain of the Berkshires, northern Litchfield Hills, & northern Worcester Hills. ▪ Precipitation transitions to rain early Thursday morning, lingering freezing rain possible for the Berkshires.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Freezing rain may impact the Thursday morning commute. ▪ Main impacts near and above 1,000 feet. These include slick roadways and bridges. ▪ Minor ice accumulation on tree branches are possible.
FORECAST CONFIDENCE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Uncertainty remains regarding the areal coverage of freezing rain and timing of the changeover from freezing rain to rain.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Winter Weather Advisory for the higher terrain of the Berkshires, northern Worcester Hills and Litchfield Hills.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Rain moves out Friday morning. ▪ Mild temperatures, highs in the mid-50s.
