Freezing Rain Tonight



OVERVIEW:

- Period of freezing rain overnight tonight into early Thursday morning across the higher terrain of the Berkshires and northern Worcester Hills.
- Transitioning to rain by early Thursday morning, although freezing rain may linger across the highest elevations through noon.
- Soaking rain for much of Thursday with no flooding concerns.

Freezing rain arrives around midnight for higher terrain of the Berkshires, northern Litchfield Hills, & northern Worcester Hills. Precipitation transitions to rain early Thursday morning, lingering freezing

Freezing rain may impact the Thursday morning commute.

- Precipitation transitions to rain early Thursday morning, lingering freezing rain possible for the Berkshires.
- Main impacts near and above 1,000 feet. These include slick roadways and bridges.
