

## **OVERVIEW:**

- A line of strong to severe thunderstorms are possible Monday Evening as a cold front sweeps through New England
- Isolated damaging wind gusts will be the primary threat
- Storms are anticipated to be strongest over western MA & CT, weakening as they move east after sunset

TIMING	<ul> <li>Strongest storms anticipated between 5 &amp; 9pm; earlier west. Scattered rain showers through midnight as storms weaken and move east.</li> </ul>	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul> <li>Isolated damaging wind gusts. Gusts exceeding 58 mph possible, most likely across the Connecticut River Valley</li> <li>Localized downpours in heavier thunderstorms leading to street and poor drainage flooding in typical locations</li> </ul>	
NWS ALERTS	<ul> <li>No watches have been issued at this time.</li> </ul>	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul> <li>Timing of the cold front, exact location of strong to severe storms</li> </ul>	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul> <li>Brief cool down to seasonable conditions, upper 60s and low 70s, mid week.
