


OVERVIEW:

- Above normal temperatures persist into tomorrow
- Heat index values 95-100F.
- Isolated to scattered strong thunderstorms tomorrow afternoon

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Highest heat index values during the afternoon (2- 5 pm)▪ Window for strong T-Storms will be 2-10 PM	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Potential for heat related issues to at risk population and those doing higher levels of outdoor physical activities.▪ Temperatures in urban areas will struggle to drop below 70F tonight.▪ Damaging wind gusts and hail possible with strongest t-storms.	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Heat Advisory remains in effect through tomorrow for most areas away from the coast.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Coverage of t-storms Sunday: best chance northern and western MA and northwest CT. Severity of the storms will depend on the timing of the approaching cold front.
