

WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Increasing heat/humidity as the week progresses. Reaching oppressive levels on Thursday.
- May still be at oppressive levels on Friday, but confidence is moderate at this time.

TIMING	▪ Oppressive heat peaks on Thursday and may linger into Friday	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	▪ Heat related issues to at risk population and those doing outdoor physical activities.	
NWS ALERTS	▪ None at this time. A Heat Advisory will probably be needed on Thursday.	
FORECAST CHALLENGE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Humidity levels on Thursday - could lead to Excessive Heat Watches/Warnings being needed for parts of the region.▪ Temperatures on Friday - if cooler then we may stay just below Heat Advisory criteria.	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Cold front brings showers & storms on Friday perhaps into Saturday.▪ Temperatures return to seasonable levels by Saturday.
