

- Heat Indices in the middle to upper 90s persist Sat through Mon.

<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	▪ Heat related issues to at risk population and those doing outdoor physical activities.	
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	▪ Heat Advisories In Effect Thu and Fri except the Cape and Islands.	
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Potential for a few locations to see Heat Indices between over 105 on Thursday and Friday. An upgrade to an Excessive Heat Warning is possible for some locations.</li><li>▪ Heat Advisories may need to be expanded onto Cape Cod for Friday.</li></ul>	
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Showers and thunderstorms will be possible Friday with a cold front.</li><li>▪ Heat &amp; Humidity persist this weekend into Monday.
