## OVERVIEW:

- Potential for scattered strong to severe thunderstorms Friday afternoon into early evening.
- Main threat is damaging straight-line wind gusts and locally heavy rainfall. There could also be some large hail.

### TIMING

- Noon to 9 PM Friday.

### HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Damaging wind and large hail. Localized urban and poor drainage flooding from heavy rainfall is also possible.
- The area of greatest risk is interior MA and northern CT.

### FORECAST CHALLENGES

- How strong the storms will become and areal coverage. The strongest storms may be confined to northern New England.

### POST-EVENT OUTLOOK

- Mainly dry this weekend, but can't rule out a brief shower or thunderstorm.
- Highs upper 70s to mid 80s this weekend.
