OVERVIEW:

- Scattered strong to severe thunderstorms this afternoon into early evening.
- Main threat is damaging straight-line wind gusts, locally heavy rainfall, hail, and a low threat for an isolated tornado.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Noon to 10 PM.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Damaging wind and hail and a low risk for an isolated tornado. ▪ Localized flash flooding from heavy rainfall is also possible. ▪ The area of greatest risk is interior MA and northern CT.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ How strong the storms will become and areal coverage. ▪ Intensity of rainfall with storms. There is a low risk for localized 3-4 inch rainfall amounts in a short time which would pose a flash flood threat.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Mainly dry this weekend, but can't rule out a brief shower or thunderstorm. ▪ Highs upper 70s to mid 80s this weekend.
