WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Periods of very heavy rain Monday and Tuesday may lead to areas of flash flooding.
- Flood Watch in effect until 5 pm Tuesday

TIMING

- Areas of very heavy rain & associated flash flooding in northeast MA, slowly spreads southwest in RI, CT & central MA

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Localized flash flooding is possible wherever heaviest rainfall occurs.
- 2 to 4 inches of rainfall thru Tuesday is expected, with locally 5 to 7 inches possible.

NWS ALERTS

- Flood Watch in effect until 5 pm Tuesday.

Drying trend Tue night, then dry weather Wednesday through next weekend

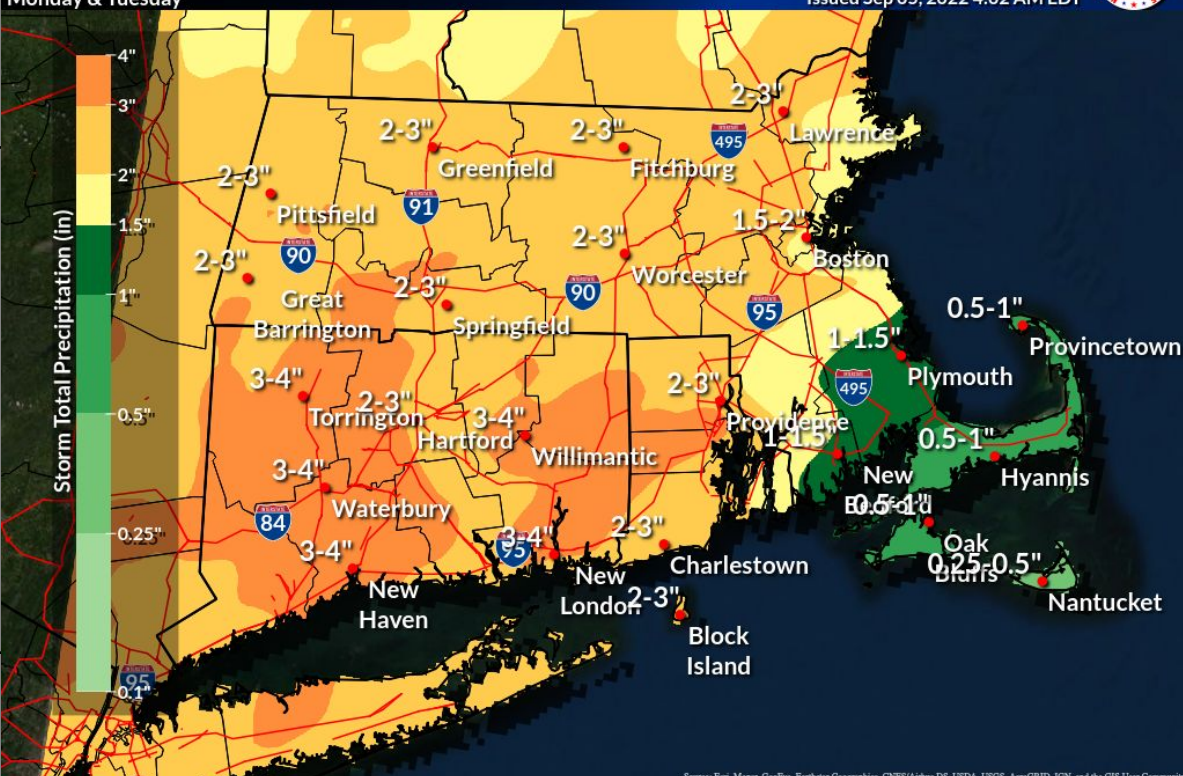
