OVERVIEW:

- Strong to severe thunderstorms possible across southern New England on Tuesday.
- Main threats include locally heavy rainfall, damaging straight-line wind gusts, and a low risk for an isolated tornado.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Damaging wind gusts and a low risk for an isolated tornado.▪ Localized urban/poor drainage flooding from heavy rainfall	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Areal coverage of strong to severe storms, and if storms reach eastern coastal areas.▪ Greatest risk for severe weather will be across western MA/northern CT this afternoon.
