

OVERVIEW:

- Widespread 1-2" of rain with locally higher amounts of 3-4+ inches across portions of central MA and CT
- Southeast wind gusts of 30-45 mph or higher, especially if there are thunderstorms

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Rain becomes more widespread this evening, is heaviest tonight into Friday morning, and ends on Friday ▪ Strongest gusts - tonight into Friday morning
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Localized urban/poor drainage flooding possible ▪ Impacts to the Friday morning commute expected ▪ Downed trees and possible power outages
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Flood watch in effect from 8 pm tonight through late tomorrow morning for areas west of I-495 ▪ Windy advisory in effect from 2am tonight through 1pm tomorrow for South Coast, Cape, Islands, and Cape Ann
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ How widespread thunderstorms will be.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Dry on Sat with seasonal temps
