OVERVIEW:

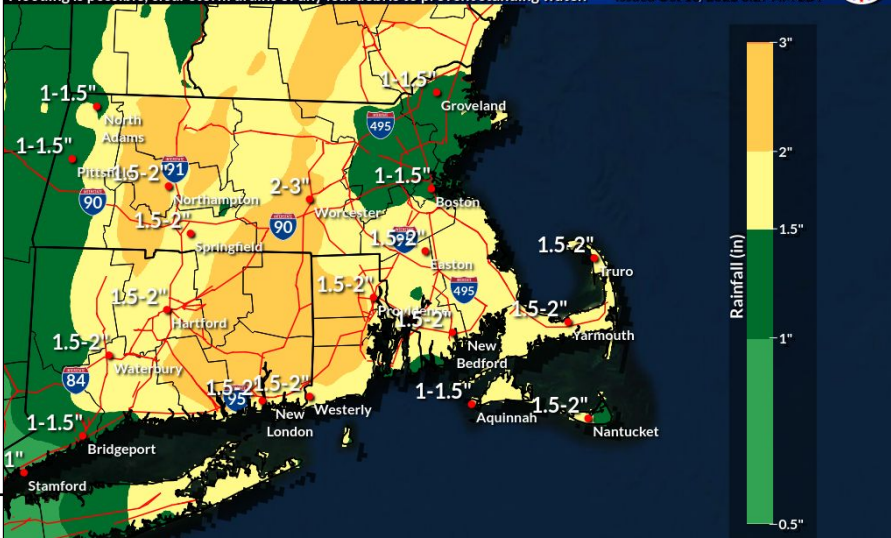
- Widespread 1-2" of rain with locally higher amounts
- Southeast wind gusts of 30-45 mph or higher, especially if there are thunderstorms

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Rain becomes more widespread this afternoon, is heaviest tonight into Friday morning, and ends on Friday▪ Strongest gusts - tonight into Friday morning
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Localized urban/poor drainage flooding possible▪ Impacts to the Friday morning commute expected▪ Downed trees and possible power outages
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ How widespread thunderstorms will be▪ Exact timing and location of heaviest rains
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Dry on Sat with seasonal temps
