HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A coating to 2" of snow expected north and west of Worcester resulting in slick roads, with little to no accumulation from Worcester south & east Isolated amounts of 3"+ across the high terrain of the Berkshires Brief period of mixed precipitation possible, including light freezing drizzle, across western MA Wednesday morning as snow transitions to rain 	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No advisories, watches, or warnings expect with this event 	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Precipitation onset/end timing. A faster/slower progression of the system would shift the timing of snow earlier/later Timing of transition from snow to rain 	
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> NO accumulating snow is expected along the I-95 corridor, with little to no impact in any of our major cities. A few novelty flakes may fly across metro-west and metro-Hartford.
