OVERVIEW:

- First accumulating snow of the season north and west of Worcester
- NO significant impact expected across the major metropolitan areas

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Late tonight through Wednesday morning
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ A coating to 2" of snow expected north and west of Worcester, resulting in slick roads, with little to no accumulation from Worcester south & east ▪ Isolated amounts of 3"+ across the high terrain of the Berkshires ▪ Brief period of mixed precipitation possible, including light freezing drizzle, across western MA Wednesday morning as snow transitions to rain
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Winter Weather Advisories for the Berkshires and portions of north central MA, as well as for portions of northwest CT
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Precipitation onset/end timing. A faster/slower progression of the system would have a significant effect on snow and ice accumulations ▪ Timing of transition from snow to rain
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ NO accumulating snow is expected along the I-95 corridor, with little to no impact in any of our major cities. A few novelty flakes may fly across metro-west and metro-Hartford.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Below normal temperatures and gusty westerly winds Thursday through Saturday ▪ Scattered showers/flurries possible Thursday & Friday
