

# Strong Winds late Wed into Thu



## OVERVIEW:

- Strong south winds developing Wednesday afternoon and evening, followed by strong west winds Wednesday night through Thursday. Peak gusts up to 50 mph possible.
- Rain, heavy at times Wednesday afternoon into Wednesday night.

<b>TIMING</b>	▪ Strongest wind gusts and heaviest rains late Wednesday afternoon into Wednesday evening. Coinciding with the Wednesday evening commute.	
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	▪ Gusty winds could lead to minor tree damage, and possible power outages. ▪ Winds remain gusty on Thursday, which could impact power restoration efforts.	
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	▪ None at this time	
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	▪ Higher uncertainty with the strength of the southerly winds Wednesday afternoon into the evening. ▪ Confidence greater in the strength of the westerly winds late Wednesday night through Thursday.
