- Strong south winds developing Wednesday afternoon and evening, followed by strong west winds Wednesday night through Thursday. Peak gusts up to 55 mph possible.
- Rain, heavy at times Wednesday afternoon into Wednesday night.

TIMING	 Strongest wind gusts 3pm-9pm Wednesday, then again Thursday afternoon. 	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	 Gusty winds could lead to minor tree damage, and possible power outages. Winds remain gusty on Thursday, which could impact power restoration efforts. 	
NWS ALERTS	 Wind Advisory for central/eastern Massachusetts and Rhode Island. May need to be expanded into western Massachusetts and Connecticut. 	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	 Lower confidence with the strength of the southerly winds Wednesday afternoon into the evening. Higher confidence in the strength of the westerly winds late Wednesday night through Thursday. 	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	 Widespread rain ends Wednesday night. Winds remain strong through Thursday. Cooler with highs in the 40s. 	Harting of the second s
