## **OVERVIEW:**

- Strong south winds developing this afternoon and evening, followed by strong west winds tonight through Thursday. Peak gusts up to 55 mph possible.
- Rain, falling heavy at times thru late tonight.

TIMING	<ul> <li>Strongest south wind thru 10pm today all of southern New England</li> <li>Strongest west wind 10am-6pm Thursday across interior Massachusetts.</li> </ul>	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul> <li>Minor tree damage and possible power outages.</li> <li>Duration of strong winds (e.g. gusts resume from the west on Thurs) could impact power restoration efforts.</li> </ul>	
NWS ALERTS	<ul> <li>Wind Advisory in CT today, in MA and RI today through Thursday</li> </ul>	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul> <li>Timing of frontal passage and shift in wind direction from S to W</li> <li>Multi-period peak winds, peaking across SE MA/RI/CT thru tonight, and for interior MA Thursday afternoon. Winds will fall below advisory levels overnight before becoming strong &amp; gusty again Thursday afternoon.</li> </ul>
