





OVERVIEW:

- Potential for accumulating snow for areas west of I-495.
- Highest totals likely across far western Massachusetts and Connecticut.

TIMING	▪ Starting Sunday afternoon and wrapping up early Monday morning.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Slippery travel Sunday afternoon through early Monday on untreated roadways as 1-3" of snow is possible from Worcester to the eastern slopes of the Berkshires.</li><li>▪ Isolated higher snowfall amounts are possible in potential snow banding.</li></ul>	
NWS ALERTS	▪ None at this time, but Winter Weather Advisories may be needed for western Massachusetts and Connecticut.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ Potential for a heavier band of snow to develop across Connecticut and western Massachusetts that may bring locally higher snowfall amounts.
