## **OVERVIEW:**

- Increased confidence in accumulating snowfall across much of southern New England.
- Highest totals forecast across far western Massachusetts and Connecticut. Minor to no accumulation expected east of I-95.

TIMING

 Starting Sunday afternoon and wrapping up late Sunday night. Clearing skies will develop by the Monday morning commute.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

Slippery travel Sunday afternoon through Sunday night on untreated roadways as 2-4" of snow is possible from Worcester to the eastern slopes of the Berkshires. Highest (4 or 5") snow totals are expected in western Franklin, Hampshire, and Hampden Counties.


 How far east the accumulating reaches. High confidence in the forecast for western MA and CT, moderate in totals east of Worcester/Providence.
