- Increased confidence in accumulating snowfall across much of southern New England.
- Highest totals forecast across far western Massachusetts and Connecticut. Minor to no accumulation expected east of I-95.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Slippery travel Sunday afternoon through Sunday night on untreated roadways as 2-4" of snow is possible from Worcester to the eastern slopes of the Berkshires. Highest (4 or 5") snow totals are expected in western Franklin, Hampshire, and Hampden Counties.

FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ How far east the accumulating reaches. High confidence in the forecast for western MA and CT, moderate in totals east of Worcester/Providence.
