



OVERVIEW:

- Accumulating snow expected Sunday afternoon & Sunday night.
- Highest totals western MA/western CT particularly in the Berks.
- Greatest uncertainty is how far east accumulating snow reaches.
- Accumulating snow ends before the Monday AM Commute.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Snow develops Sunday afternoon and continues at times Sunday night. ▪ Accumulating snow will end before the Monday AM commute. 	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Slippery travel Sunday afternoon through Sunday night on untreated roadways as 2-5" of snow is possible from Worcester to the eastern slopes of the Berkshires. Highest (4 or 5") snow totals are expected in western Franklin, Hampshire, and Hampden Counties. 	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Winter Weather Advisories for western MA as well as Litchfield and Hartford counties in CT. 	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ How far east the accumulating reaches. High confidence in the forecast for western MA and CT, moderate in totals east of Worcester/Providence. ▪ Does Central MA and parts of RI receive a few inches of snow or less than an inch is the greatest uncertainty right now. 	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Cooler than normal, highs in the 30s along with drier weather conditions.
