



OVERVIEW:

- Accumulating snow expected Sunday afternoon & Sunday night.
- Highest totals western MA/western CT particularly in the Berks.
- Greatest uncertainty is how far east accumulating snow reaches.
- Accumulating snow ends before the Monday AM Commute.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Snow develops Sunday afternoon and continues at times Sunday night. ▪ Accumulating snow will end before the Monday AM commute.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Slippery travel Sunday afternoon through Sunday night on untreated roadways as 2-6" of snow is possible from Worcester to the eastern slopes of the Berkshires. Highest (5 or 6") snow totals are expected in western Hartford, Hampshire, and Hampden Counties where snowfall rates may approach 1" per hour
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Winter Weather Advisories for Hampshire, Franklin, and Hampden counties in MA, and for Hartford and Tolland counties in CT
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ How far east the accumulating reaches. High confidence in the forecast for western MA and CT, moderate in totals east of Worcester/Providence.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Cooler than normal, highs in the 30s along with drier weather conditions.
NEXT BRIEFING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ This will be the last briefing unless significant changes are made to the forecast
