OVERVIEW:

- Heavy wet snow is possible Thursday night into Friday across the higher elevations of western MA & northwest CT. In addition, strong, gusty east winds, along with periods of moderate to heavy rain may result in minor street/highway flooding

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Thursday night, Friday, possibly lingering into Fri night
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Heavy wet snow possible across the high terrain, and may be accompanied by snow load issues, such as power outages.▪ Increasing east winds may exacerbate snow load issues.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ None at this time, however headlines may be issued Wednesday afternoon
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ How much snow and at what elevation will snow accumulations commence? Extent & areal coverage of impacts from heavy wet snow.
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Increasing east winds Friday may increase the impacts of potential power outages if heavy wet snow totals exceed 6+ inches across the high terrain.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Turning drier and not quite as windy Saturday
