FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Low forecast confidence in areal coverage and duration of subfreezing temperatures, along with freezing rain/drizzle.	
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ More specific information will be provided Tuesday and Wednesday, as forecast confidence increases.	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Freezing rain/drizzle will likely transition to light snow Thursday night and Friday.
