


Potential Ice Wed night/Thu

OVERVIEW:

- Rain Wednesday likely changes to freezing rain/drizzle overnight & Thursday
- Locations - Higher elevations of western and central MA.
- Untreated roads/surfaces may become icy; impacting the Thurs AM commute

TIMING	▪ Wednesday night & Thursday	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Freezing rain/drizzle may result in untreated roads/surfaces becoming icy.▪ Western & central Massachusetts, including the Route 2 corridor. Impacts possible as far east as northern Essex Co.	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ A winter weather advisory is not in effect at this time but is likely to be considered with further updates	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Low forecast confidence in areal coverage and duration of subfreezing temperatures, along with freezing rain/drizzle.▪ Will sub-freezing temps/icing expand southward?	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Freezing rain/drizzle will likely transition to light snow Thursday night and Friday. Only minor accums are expected.
