OVERVIEW:

- Potential for accumulating snow Sunday into Monday

TIMING

- Sunday into Monday morning.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Rain mixing with sleet/snow, before changing to snow. Slippery road conditions, especially Sunday night. Relatively long duration of light snow. Some potential for localized ocean-effect enhancement. N/NNE winds gusting to 40-50 mph along the coast.

NWS ALERTS

- No winter weather headlines at this time.
- Wind Advisories posted for portions of coastal southeast MA, including the Cape and islands

POST-EVENT OUTLOOK

- Some question as to whether more snow could move into northern MA from the NE Monday.
- Drier and milder Tuesday.

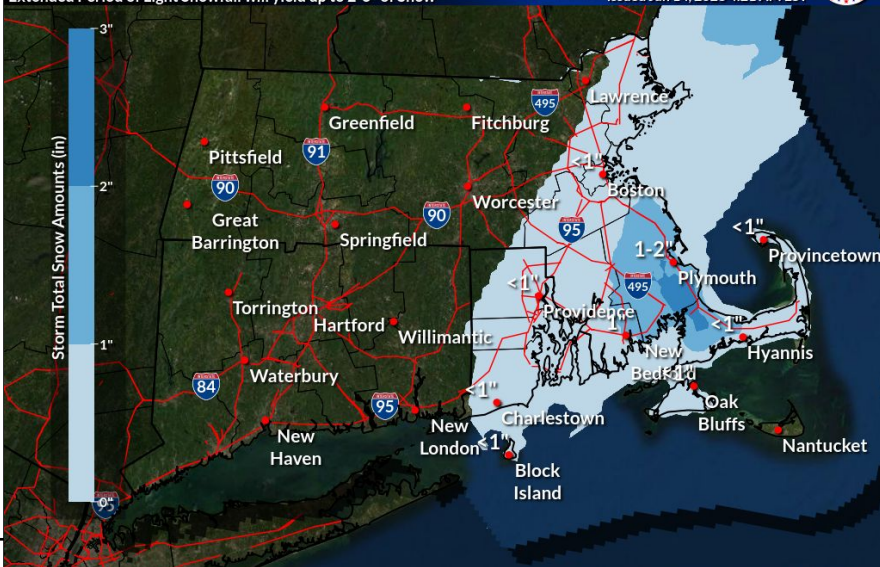
Storm Total Snowfall 7 PM Saturday through 1 PM Monday
