

WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Periods of snow and mixed precipitation Thursday afternoon through Friday, especially north of I-90.
- Untreated roads and surfaces may become snow covered and slick.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Thursday afternoon through Friday.▪ Heaviest precipitation late Thursday into early Friday.▪ Precipitation tapers off late Friday.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Untreated roads/surfaces may become slick.▪ May impact the I-91 corridor commute Thursday PM.▪ More widespread impacts to the Friday AM commute for the interior.	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ No alerts at this time.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Confidence in snowfall/icing totals is moderate. Uncertainty lies in the exact precipitation types and duration late Thursday into early Friday.
