

# Snow/Icing Late Thu - Fri



## OVERVIEW:

- Periods of snow and mixed precipitation Thursday afternoon through Friday, especially north of I-90.
- Untreated roads and surfaces may become snow covered and slick.
- Minor coastal flooding during the Friday/Saturday morning high tide is possible along the east coast.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Thursday afternoon through Friday.</li><li>▪ Heaviest precipitation late Thursday into early Friday.</li><li>▪ Precipitation tapers off late Friday.</li></ul>	
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Untreated roads/surfaces may become slick.</li><li>▪ May impact the I-91 corridor commute Thursday PM.</li><li>▪ More widespread impacts to the Friday AM commute for the interior.</li></ul>	
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Winter Weather Advisory in effect for Berkshire, Hampshire, Hampden, Franklin, Worcester, Middlesex, and Essex counties in MA and Hartford and Litchfield counties in CT noon Thursday - 6pm Friday.</li></ul>	
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Exact precipitation types and duration late Thursday into early Friday.</li><li>▪ Southward extent of snowfall early Friday</li></ul>	
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Drier for much of the weekend with more seasonable temperatures.</li></ul>	
<b>NEXT BRIEFING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ 6 AM Thursday</li></ul>
